

APPRENTICESHIP TEST PREPARATION

Programs offered through Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) require the following score levels on the TABE entrance test:

	<i>Reading Grade Level</i>	<i>Math Grade Level</i>
Plumbing/Pipefitting	8.0	8.0
Sheet Metal/ HVAC	8.0	10.0
Electrical*	10.0	9.6

You are allowed to take the TABE test two times. If you don't pass after two attempts, you must complete a Math & Reading Review course. Approximately 60 hours are required to complete each course. Prior to testing a third time, you must submit a Certificate of Completion (to ABC).

**Electrician apprentices must also show that they have completed an Algebra course with a grade of "C" or higher, either at the high school or college level. Algebra credit may be earned at many of the review locations listed on the back of this flyer.*

1. If you prefer to refresh your English/math skills before taking the TABE Test, you can attend FREE review classes offered by the San Diego Community College District. These are open entry classes that may be started at almost anytime. Review locations and phone numbers are listed on the back of this flyer. Please call the review location for available class times.
2. Take this flyer with you to the review class and inform the instructor that you need to prepare for the TABE Test and that you need to meet the above skill levels in English and math.
3. The instructor will have you register for the class by filling out a simple form. There is NO COST for the class. The instructor can determine the type of review best suited to your current skills.
