## **SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS/GUIDELINES**

*The NAWIC San Fernando Valley Chapter #153 will annually seek scholarship candidates, both men and women, who possess a commitment to obtaining an education leading to a degree through a course of study in construction.*

*All applicants must have a 3.0 (B) grade point average.*

*The NAWIC San Fernando Valley Chapter #153 Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Appointments for personal interviews will be arranged. Completed applications, current official transcripts and scholarship resumes must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than the 1st Friday in March of each year. Applications received after the 1st Friday in March will NOT be considered. The Scholarship Committee will select a recipient(s) and present the recipient(s) to the Board of Directors. Following the Board approval, all applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision.*

*Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but each recipient will be considered for subsequent awards if he/she provides evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, continued enrollment, and good standing in a college program leading to a degree in a construction related field. Scholarship recipient(s) MUST maintain an overall 3.0 (B) grade point average. Official academic transcripts must be included with the scholarship application. Application must include the social security number of the applicant.*

*Scholarship recipient(s) are requested to maintain frequent contact with the NAWIC San Fernando Valley Chapter #153 and attend chapter functions when possible.*

*The recipient(s) will be invited to the NAWIC San Fernando Valley Chapter #153 Executive Appreciation Evening at which time the scholarship(s) will be presented.*

*In order to maintain 501(c)(6) tax-exempt status, scholarship(s) may not be awarded to NAWIC members or their families.*

*The National Association of Women in Construction is an equal opportunity organization.*

*Scholarship awards are at the sole discretion of the NAWIC San Fernando Valley Chapter #153.*
